Constituency Statistics Report 2026

Introduction

This report brings together key statistics about the constituency of Grouville & St Martin to help inform and support constituents ahead of the June 2026 elections in Jersey. By presenting clear, accessible data on the makeup of our community, the report aims to provide a useful snapshot of local demographics, social characteristics and housing trends relevant to voters, candidates and anyone with an interest in the constituency.

The information in this report has been sourced from Statistics Jersey, drawing primarily on the most recent [Jersey Census in 2021](#) and the [Jersey Opinions and Lifestyle Survey 2025](#). These statistics offer the most reliable and comprehensive picture of life within Grouville & St Martin and cover areas such as population, age structure, employment, household composition and other key indicators that help illustrate the character of our constituency.

Key Figures

Population

Grouville & St Martin had a combined population of **9,350**, making it the least populated constituency. Its population was almost 50% smaller than St Saviour, the most populated constituency.

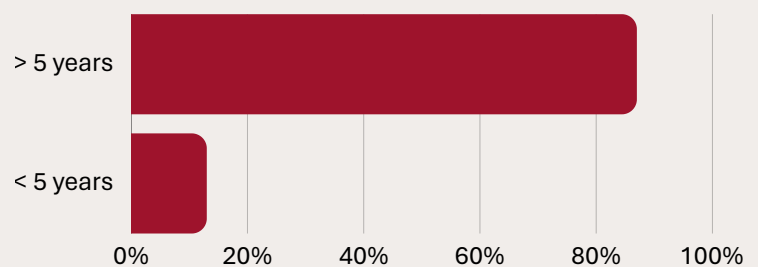

Length of residence in Jersey

Approximately **1 in 8** (13%) of Grouville & St Martin residents had lived in Jersey for fewer than 5 years and **87%** for more than 5 years.

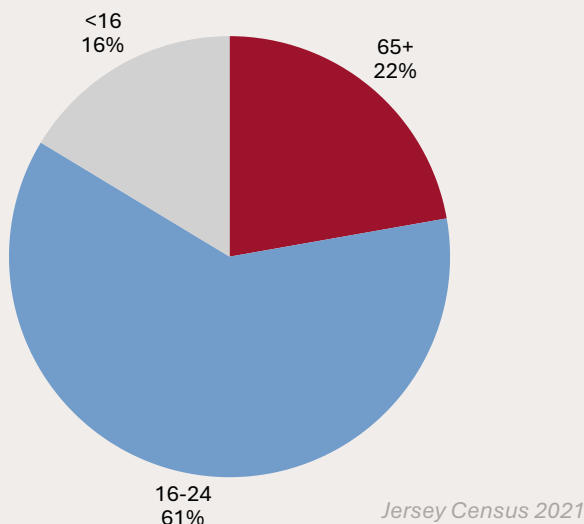

Key Figures

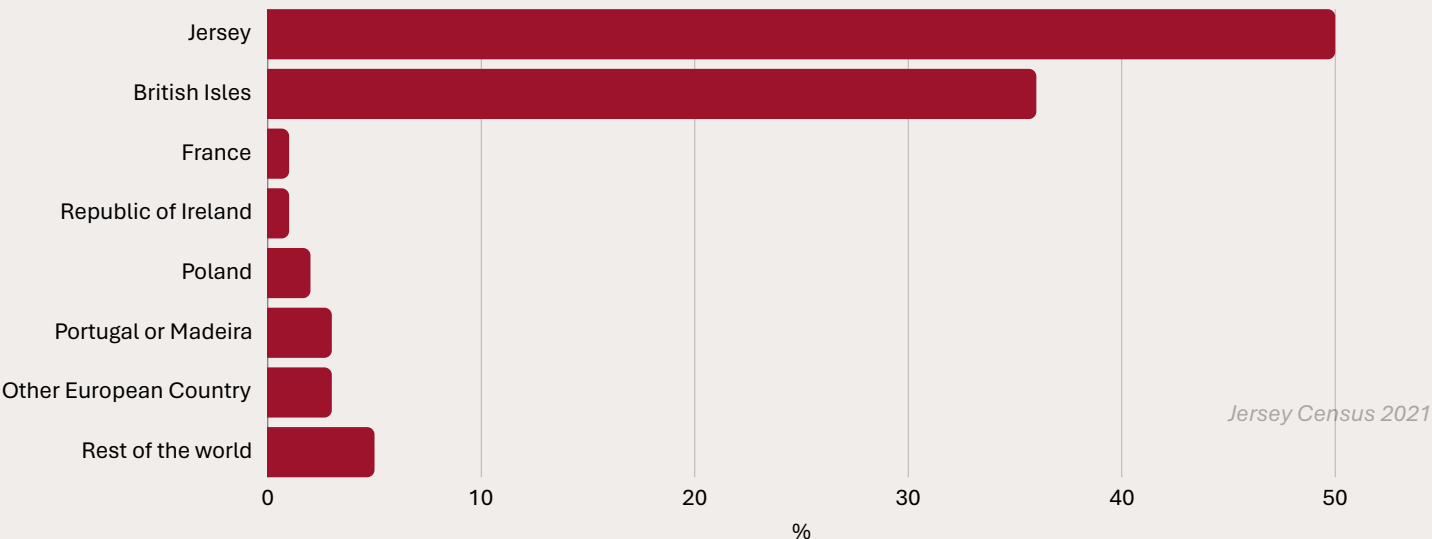
Young, working-age and elderly people

This constituency had one of the lowest percentages of working-age people (**61%**), (joint with St Mary, St Ouen & St Peter, and St Brelade). Just over **1 in 5 (22%)** residents of Grouville & St Martin were aged 65+.



Place of birth and ethnicity

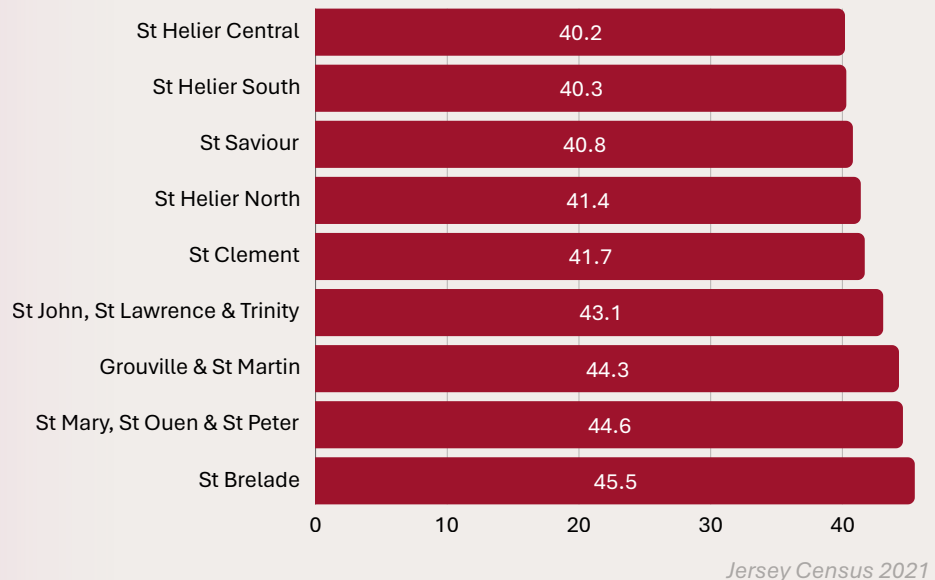
Grouville & St Martin had **430 residents** born outside of Europe, which was the second lowest of all constituencies (highest in St Helier Central at 1,050). This accounted for just under 5% of Grouville & St Martin’s population.



Demographics

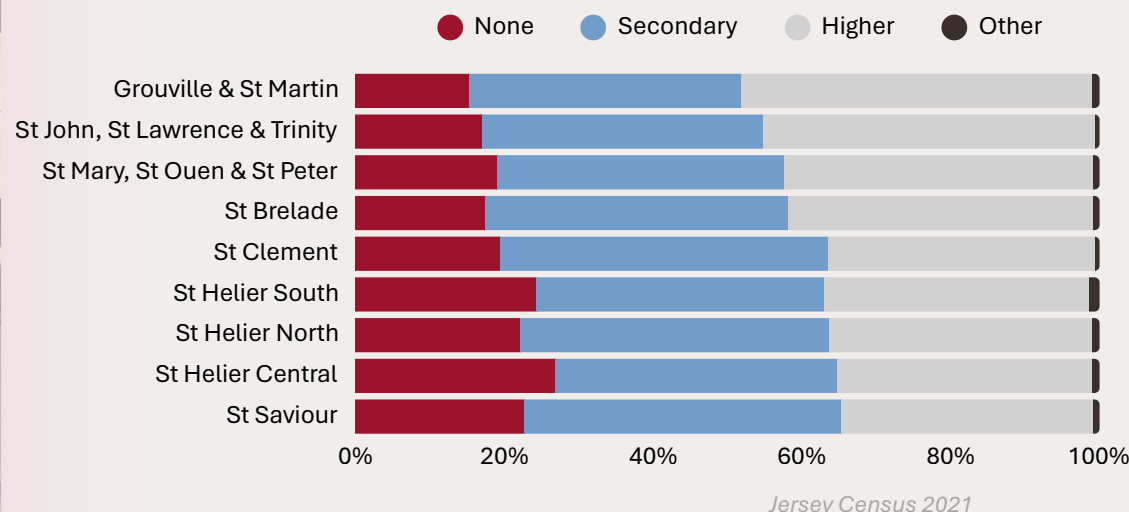
Average age

The mean age of Grouville & St Martin residents was **44.3 years**; the third highest of all constituencies.



Higher Education Attainment

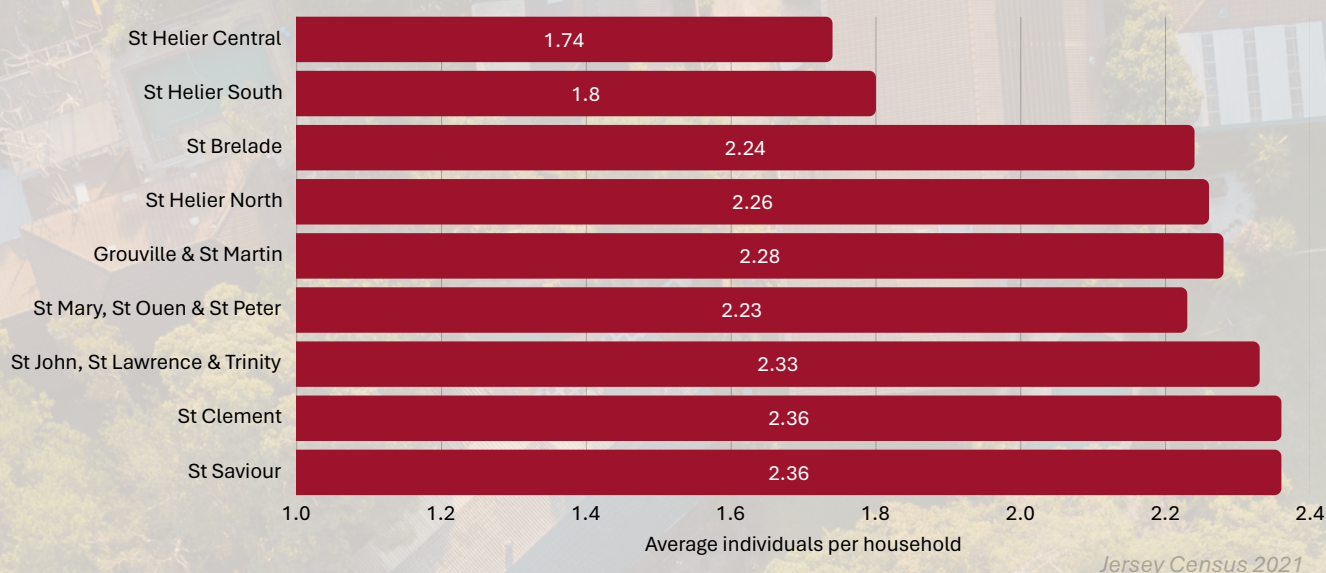
Almost half (47%) of Grouville & St Martin adults were educated to a Higher level, which was the highest of all constituencies. This was compared to 34% in St Saviour.



Housing & Households

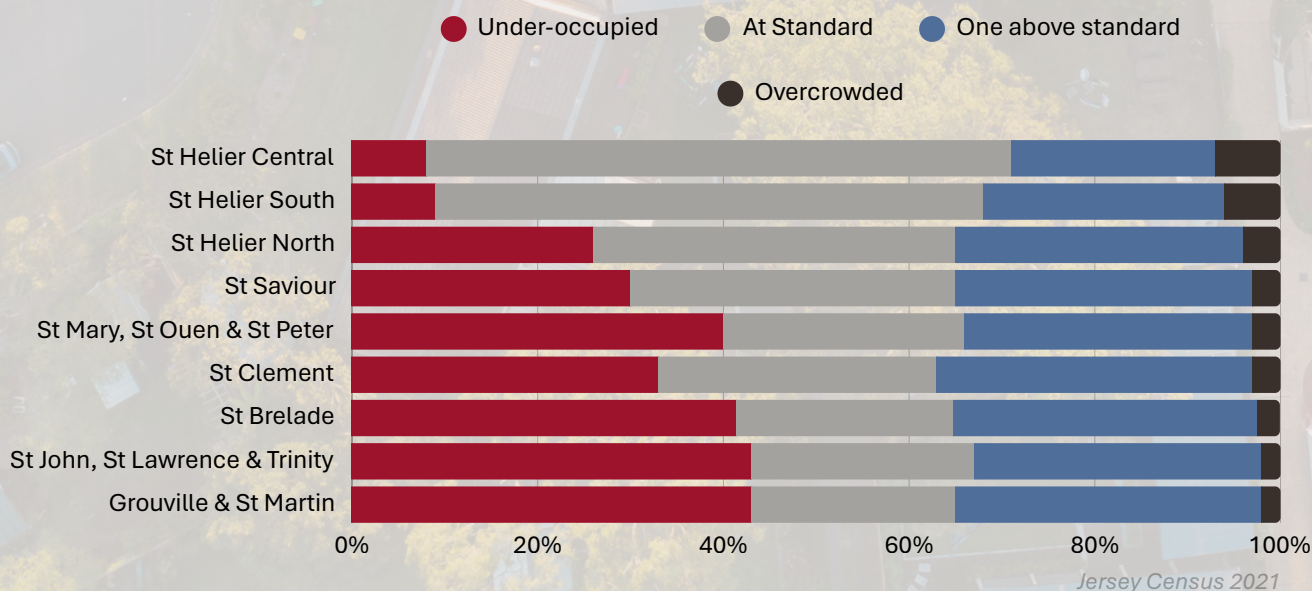
Size of households

Grouville & St Martin had the joint highest average household size of all constituencies. An average of **2.36** individuals resided per household compared to 1.74 in St Helier Central.



Overcrowding

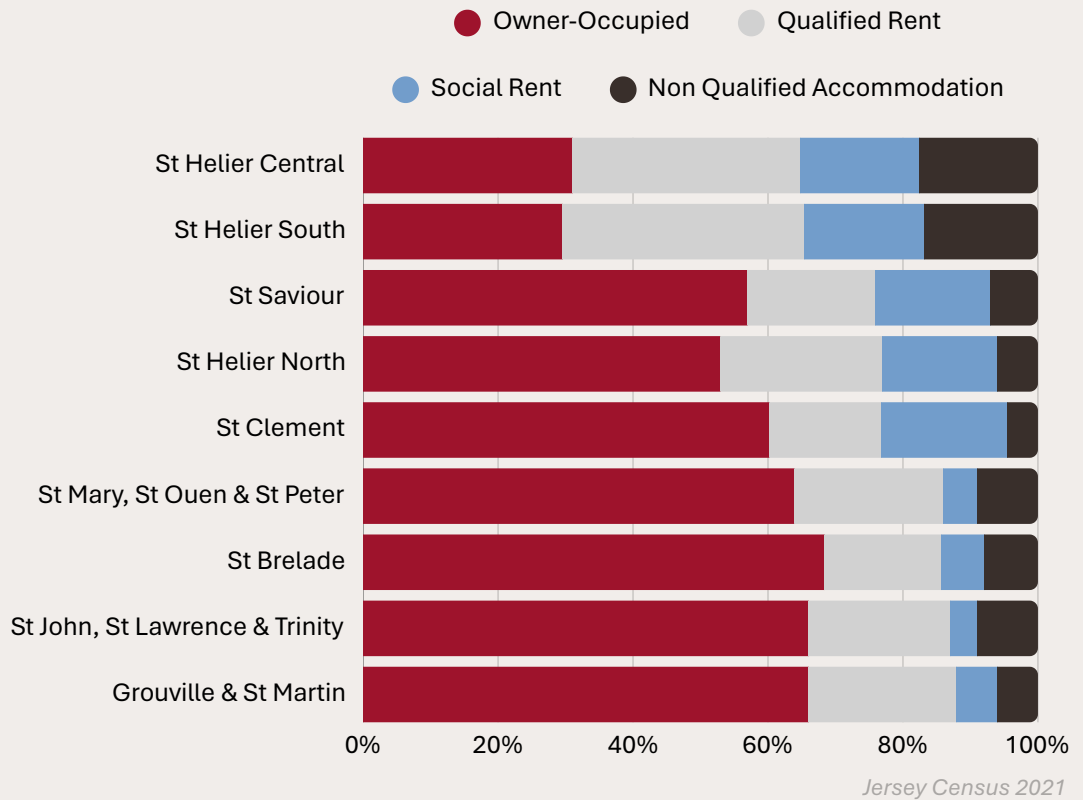
This constituency recorded the lowest overcrowding rate at **2%**, equal with St Brelade and St John, St Lawrence & Trinity, and lower than all other constituencies. Grouville & St Martin had the highest level of under-occupancy at **43%**, matching St John, St Lawrence & Trinity.



Housing & Households

Tenure

Two-thirds of households (66%) were owner-occupied in Grouville & St Martin. Only **six percent** of households were in social rental properties, which was 3 times fewer than in urban districts.



Cars per household

The average number of cars per household in Grouville & St Martin was 1.81 (third highest of all constituencies). Only **11%** of households had no car, compared to 44% in St Helier Central.

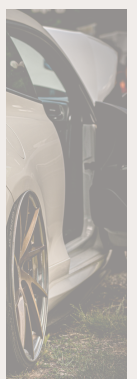

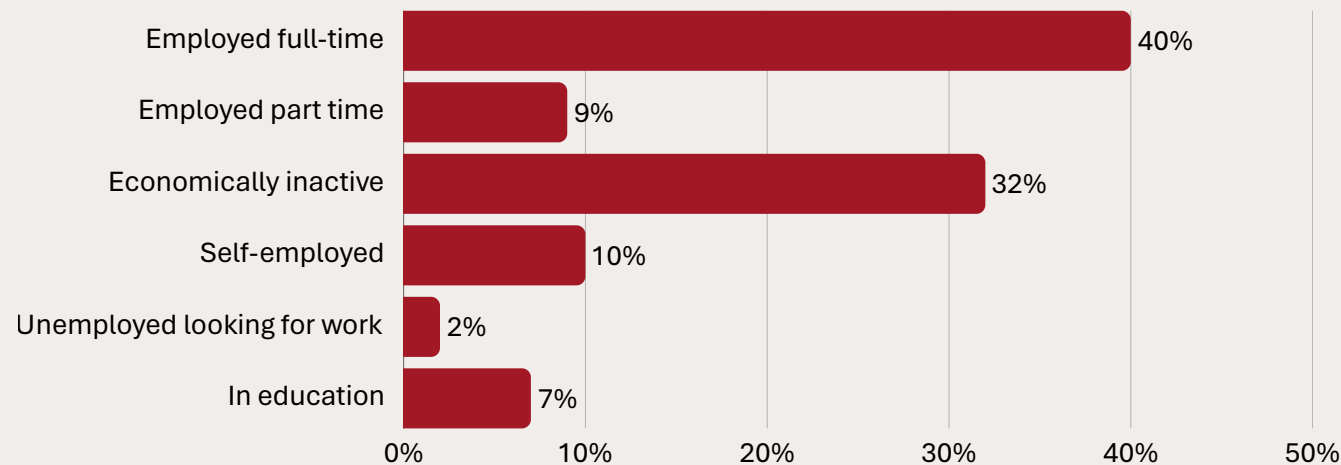


Cost of Living

Economic status

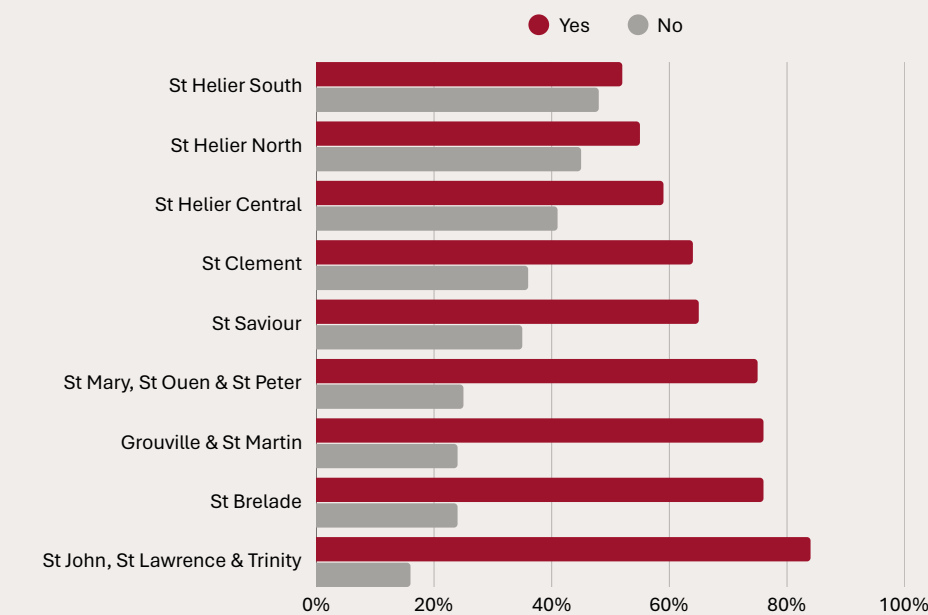
Grouville & St Martin had one of the lowest proportions of adults in full-time employment at **40%**. In contrast, St Helier Central had the highest rate at 62%. Around **one in three** adults in Grouville & St Martin were economically inactive (32%).

Unexpected Expense

Grouville & St Martin had the third highest proportion (**76%**) of respondent households who could afford an unnecessary expense, compared to the lowest district of 52% in St Helier South.

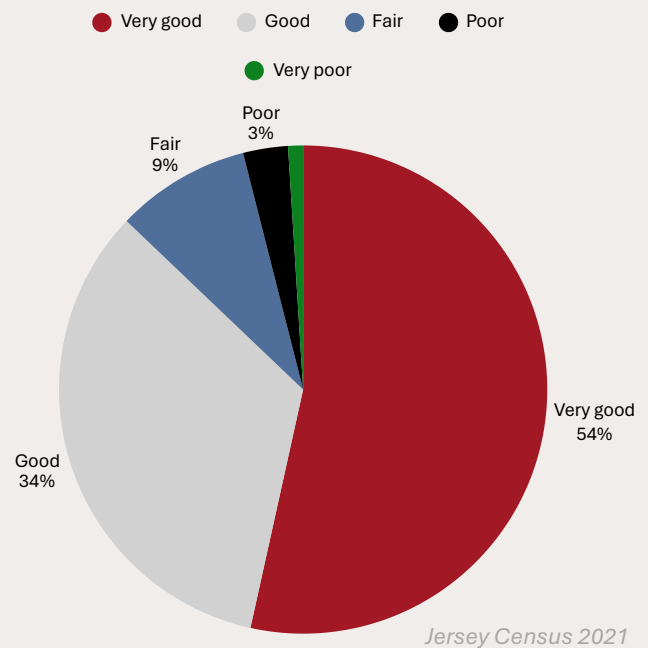




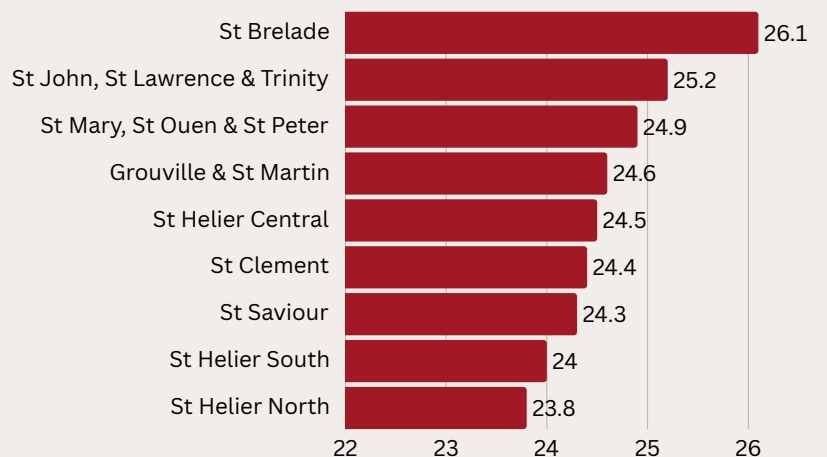
Health & Wellbeing

Physical and mental health

Grouville & St Martin had the highest proportion of people who reported being in very good health (**54%**), equal with St John, St Lawrence & Trinity. This was compared with St Helier Central, which had the lowest proportion at 42%.



Residents scored the fourth highest for their overall mental wellbeing (including life satisfaction, happiness, anxiety and feeling worthwhile) with a mean score of **24.6**.



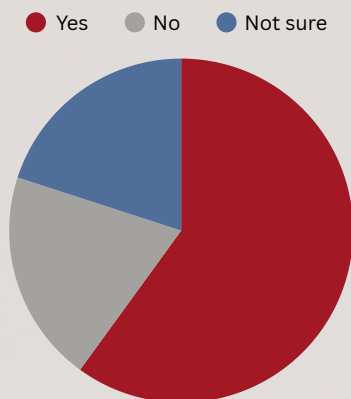

Civic Engagement

In 2022, **82%** of the Grouville & St Martin voting age population were registered to vote. However, the percentage of registered voters who voted was **51%**.

Voting intentions

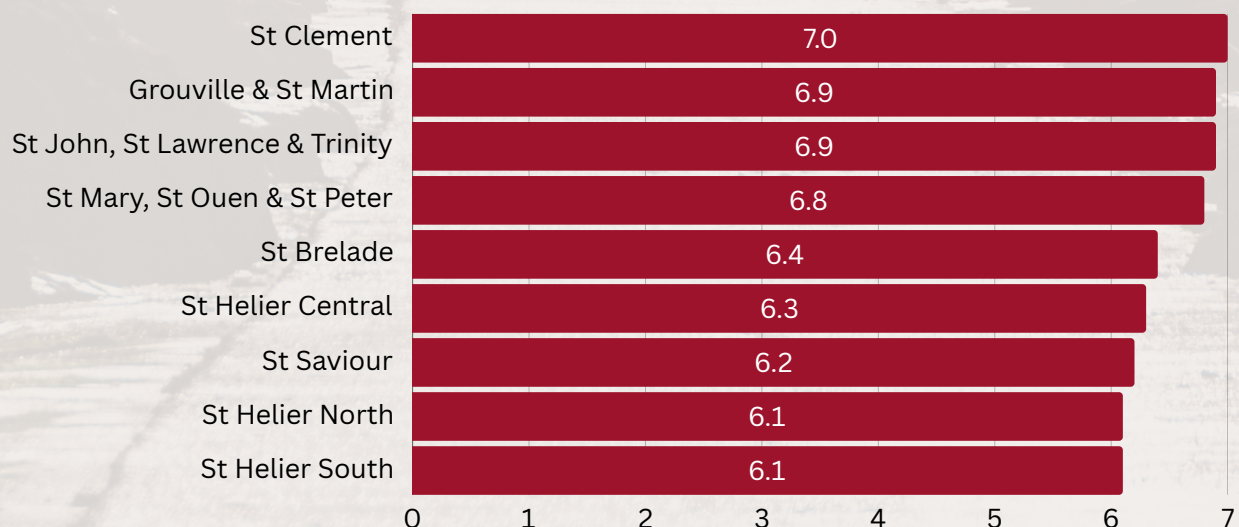
Grouville & St Martin had the highest proportion of respondents planning to vote in the 2026 election (**60%**) of all constituencies. Twenty percent said they wouldn't vote and 20% said they were unsure.

Trust in Government

Grouville & St Martin had one of the highest mean trusts in Government at **5.9** (compared with St Saviour which had the lowest mean trust of 5.4).

Trust in Your Constituency

Grouville & St Martin had the second highest mean trust score in its constituency at **6.9**.
