On 21 July 2022, the Minister for Economic Development, Tourism, Sport and Culture made a Ministerial Decision delegating certain of his functions under Articles 28, 30 and 30A of the <u>States of Jersey Law 2005</u> (see Decision reference MD-ETS-2022-466., available at <u>www.gov.je</u>).

The terms of the delegations, and the legislation under which those delegations were made, were recorded in a Report attached to the Ministerial Decision, as shown below –

The Minister for Economic Development, Tourism, Sport and Culture appointed Deputy Lucy Stephenson, of St Mary, St Ouen and St Peter, as an Assistant Minister with responsibility for sports policy, the promotion of sports and sports development.
