Recruitment of a permanent Chief People Officer

A full open recruitment process in Jersey took place during March 2024 which was overseen by the Jersey Appointments Commission. Lesley Darwin, the Acting Chief People Officer, was successful and formally took up the substantive post on 8th April 2024. The role was reviewed and the job description updated to reflect the operational leadership required.

Teachers' pay dispute

A meeting of the States Employment Board (SEB) was held on 5th February 2024. Deputy Malcolm Ferey, SEB Vice-Chair, and Deputy Rose Binet were in attendance with the Chief Minister. Having considered the matter, the SEB members endorsed the recommended revised pay offer to teachers and instructed the Acting Chief People Officer to take the necessary action.
