Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Act is to appoint 1st January 2003 as the day for the commencement of the provisions of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 that so far have not come into force. The Law was adopted by the States on 31st July 2001 (P.103 of 2001) and registered in the Royal Court on 4th January 2002. Most of its provisions came into force on 1st July 2002.

The provisions that have so far not come into force deal with the requirement to hold a licence under the Law, powers relating to land, offences in relation to telecommunications, the entry and search of premises, the repeal of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 1972 and the amendment and repeal of certain other legislation. They include also most of the savings and transitional and consequential provisions.

This draft Act has no implications for the financial or manpower resources of the States.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 68 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002,^[1] have made the following Act -

1. Parts 2 and 6, Articles 47 - 53, 62, 66 and 67 (to the extent that it has not come into force), and Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 (to the extent of the latter's paragraphs 1- 6), of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002^[2] shall come into force on the 1st day of January 2003.

2. This Act may be cited as the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 (Appointed Day) (No. 2) Act 200.
