"Will the Minister advise how many Income Support claims have been subject to the withholding of benefit paid through (a) sanctions, (b) overpayment charges, (c) Household Medical Account payments and (d) loan repayments on special payments; and will she provide the total sum withheld in the first quarter of 2016?"
