Scope of delegation:	Responsibility for the development of Population and Migration Policy. As part of this, the Deputy will become a Member of the Housing and Work Advisory Group Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012: The Chief Minister has delegated responsibility for the functions conferred upon her under the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012 to her Assistant Minister, Deputy L. Stephenson of St. Mary, St. Ouen and St. Peter.
