Draft States of Jersey (Powers, Privileges and Immunities) (Scrutiny Panels, PAC and PPC) (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 200-450/3(2)

A1. The Committee, with reference to its Minute No. A7 of 10th January 2007, considered the draft States of Jersey (Powers, Privileges and Immunities) (Scrutiny Panels, PAC and PPC) (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 200-, together with an accompanying report.

The Committee observed that the draft Regulations would, if adopted, enable technical advisors appointed by Scrutiny Panels to benefit from the same protection afforded to panel members and witnesses, in accordance with the wishes of the Chairmen's Committee.

The Committee approved the draft States of Jersey (Powers, Privileges and Immunities) (Scrutiny Panels, PAC and PPC) (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 200-, together with the accompanying report, and requested that they be lodged 'au Greffe' in early course.
