REPORT

The attached Regulations are being presented to the States for approval in order to fulfil a request of the Comité des Connétables to add cut flowers to the list of transactions that may be permitted by a Sunday trading permit.

These Regulations amend the Second Schedule to the Shops (Sunday Trading) (Jersey) Law 1960. The Second Schedule is a list of transactions that may be permitted by a Sunday trading permit.

The amendment has the effect that a permit may allow the sale of cut flowers, irrespective of where they were grown. Currently a permit may only allow their sale if they are sold on the holding where they have been grown.

Financial and manpower statement

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from these draft Regulations.

Explanatory Note

These Regulations amend the Second Schedule to the Shops (Sunday Trading) (Jersey) Law 1960. The Second Schedule is a list of transactions that may be permitted by a Sunday trading permit.

The amendment has the effect that a permit may allow the sale of cut flowers, irrespective of where they were grown. Currently a permit may only allow their sale if they are sold on the holding where they have been grown.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 6 of the Shops (Sunday Trading) (Jersey) Law 1960^[1], have made the following Regulations –

1 Schedule 2 of Law amended

In Schedule 2 to the Shops (Sunday Trading) (Jersey) Law 1960, in paragraph (1), for subparagraph (i) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph –

“(i) cut flowers;”.

2 Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Shops (Sunday Trading) (No. 9) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force 7 days after they are made.
