## Planning and Building (Jersey) Law 2002, as amended

The Minister for Planning and Environment has the power, under Article 25 of the above Law, to delegate the signature of planning obligation agreements on his behalf to the following officers –

- Chief Officer Planning and Environment Department
- Director of Planning
- Assistant Director Development Control.

This delegation applies to those agreements where the Minister has not previously decided that he wishes to sign the agreements himself.
