Question

Will the Minister advise which of the 15 roles advertised on the ‘Jobs in Jersey’ webpages that relate to transport, road safety, highways, highway maintenance, drainage, and energy from waste with a total salary cost of £937,335 per annum are replacement roles and which are newly-created roles?

Answer

In my response to the Connétable of St John’s Written Question (287) tabled on Monday 21st June I reported 81 vacancies within Operations & Transport Directorate for the month of May 2021.
