St. Mary's Village Plan - P.62/94

THE STATES, adopting a proposition of the Island Development Committee -

- (a) in connexion with the St. Mary's Village Plan approved the rezoning of the following areas of land designated on the Island Map 1-87, as amended -
 - (i) Field 420, measuring approximately 2.7 vergées, situated within an

area designated as Sensitive Landscape Area of the Agricultural Priority Zone, and Field 492, measuring approximately 2.5 vergées, situated within an area designated as Agricultural Priority Zone for use for Category A housing and other housing purposes as determined by the parish of Saint Mary;

- (ii) Field 482, measuring approximately 3.8 vergées, situated within an area designated as Agricultural Priority Zone for use as public open space for recreational and amenity use and for the provision of additional car parking space to serve the Parish Hall and the primary school;
- (iii) Field 497, and part of Field 498, measuring approximately 1.3 vergées, situated within areas designated as Agricultural Priority Zone and Sensitive Landscape Area of the Agricultural Priority Zone respectively, for use for a public car park, together with a strip of land on the northern boundary of field 564 required for vehicular exit purposes; and

Building Loans (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment No. 23) (Jersey) Regulations 1994 -P.64/94

THE STATES, adopting a proposition of the Social Security Committee, approved the appointment of Mr. Noel Nat Martin as chairman of the Jersey Council for Safety and Health at Work for a term of three years with effect from 1st July 1994.

Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Act 1994 - P.69/94

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Law 1951, as amended, made an Act entitled the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Act 1994.

Airport development plan - P.70/94

THE STATES, adopting a proposition of the Harbours and Airport Committee -

- (a) agreed that the Harbours and Airport Committee should continue to plan a development to improve Jersey Airport;
- (b) in the event of the States approving a recommendation of the Policy and Resources Committee during the debate on the Strategic Policy Review and Action Plan 1994, that £10 million is allocated in 1995 to the Harbours and Airport Committee for the proposed development, requested the Finance and Economics Committee to make available from this amount the sum of £450,000, on 1st July 1994, as a planning vote.
