Christmas Bonus: Introduction of means-tested bonus P.141/2015

THE STATES commenced consideration of a proposition of Deputy Geoffrey Peter Southern of St. Helier to refer to their Act dated 8th October 2015 in which they approved the Christmas Bonus (Repeal) (Jersey) Law 201- and thereby agreed that, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellency Majesty in Council, the Christmas bonus payable to all Jersey pensioners should be abolished from Christmas 2016; and rejected paragraphs (a) and (c) –

- (a) to agree that a new means-tested Christmas bonus should be introduced from December 2016 for all pensioners resident in Jersey who are not liable to pay Jersey income tax; and
- (c) to request the Minister for Social Security to bring forward for approval the necessary legislation to give effect to the proposal.
