“When promoting economic growth, what attention, if any, has the Chief Minister given in proposals for the Medium Term Financial Plan and Budget 2016 to the evidence (International Monetary Fund discussion note SDN/15/13) that increasing the income share of the top 20% decreases Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth whilst increasing the income share of the bottom 20% promotes higher GDP growth?”
2. Deputy M. Tadier of St. Brelade will ask the following question of the Chief Minister –

“Is the Chief Minister satisfied that the statement made by the Minister for Treasury and Resources on 4th February 2014, when he told the Assembly that he was ‘absolutely clear with SoJDC that their buildings are to be progressed on a fully-let basis in order to reduce the risk’ was accurate?”
- \* 3. Deputy R. Labey of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Minister for Treasury and Resources–

“What efforts, if any, are being made by Andium Homes to ensure that parking spaces assigned to Andium residents are not being occupied by unauthorised vehicles; does Andium have the same legal authority to tow such vehicles away as was the case with the former Housing Department, and, if not, what action, if any, will the Minister take?”



- \* 4. Deputy S.Y. Mézec of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Chief Minister –
- “Does the Chief Minister accept the statement on page 30 of the International Monetary Fund discussion paper SDN/15/13 that “redistribution through the tax and transfer system is found to be positively related to growth for most countries” and, if so, what, if any, redistributive measures does he have under consideration for the 2016 Budget, and if he does not accept the statement, would he outline why?”
5. Deputy J.A.N. Le Fondré of St. Lawrence will ask the following question of the Minister for Treasury and Resources –
- “Would the Minister, as shareholder representative, advise whether he considers it to be acceptable that the States of Jersey Development Company has still not supplied all requested information to the Corporate Services Scrutiny Panel in order for it to complete its review and, if so, what action does he propose to take to resolve the situation?”
6. Deputy G.P. Southern of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Chief Minister –
- “Does the Chief Minister accept the conclusions of Catherine Mann, OECD Chief Economist, that jurisdictions with bigger banking sectors suffer weaker growth and worse inequality, and what impact, if any, does her statement that ‘There can be too much finance. When the finance sector is well developed... further increases in its size usually slow long term growth’ have upon plans for growth in the Medium Term Financial Plan?”
7. Deputy S.Y. Mézec of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Minister for Treasury and Resources –
- “Can the Minister, as the shareholder representative, advise whether it was the States of Jersey Development Company’s (SoJDC) understanding that the buildings should ‘be progressed on a fully-let basis in order to reduce the risk’ as stated by the then Minister for Treasury and Resources on 4th February 2014, and if it was not, what did the SoJDC believe his instructions to be?”
8. Deputy M. Tadier of St. Brelade will ask the following question of the Minister for Health and Social Services –
- “Can the Minister confirm the total number of ward closures and bed losses that have occurred in Adult Mental Health Services in the past 3 years, as well as what the net loss/gain in bed spaces is for this period?”

**R&O.72/2015.**

The EU Legislation (Sanctions – Yemen) (Jersey) Order 2014 gives effect in Jersey to Regulation (EU) No 1352/2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen (“the 2014 Regulation”). The 2014 Regulation is amended by Council Regulation (EU) 2015/878 of 8 June 2015 (OJ L 143, 9.6.2015, p. 1) which introduces a new offence of providing technical or financial assistance relating to military activities and the provision or manufacture of arms and related materiel, to the persons named in Annex 1 to the 2014 Regulation.

*Article 1 of this Order amends the EU Legislation (Sanctions – Yemen) (Jersey) Order 2014, to update it in line with these substantive changes and add the new offence for Jersey. Article 2 gives the title of this Order and provides for its commencement.*

*The Order was made on 17th June 2015 and came into force on 18th June 2015.*
