A1. The Committee received and considered correspondence dated 1st June 2006, received from Mr. E. Trevor, Chairman, Shopmobility, regarding the use of States Members' parking spaces in Sand Street car park.

The Committee noted that, due to the increase in popularity of Shopmobility during the summer months, more parking spaces were required and Mr. Trevor was requesting permission to use additional States Members' car parking spaces on non-states days. The Committee recalled that it had agreed that it would not become involved in issues surrounding the number and location of States Members' parking spaces as it was considered that this was the responsibility of the Transport and Technical Services Department.
