Explanatory Note regarding subordinate legislation tabled at this meeting.

R&O 122/2003

This Order provides for the protection of an oak and a magnolia on land adjacent to Millbrook Manor. The Order was made on 6th November 2003, and came into force on the day it was made.

R&O 123/2003

This Order increases the fees that must accompany applications to develop land by 16.4%. These fees were last increased on 15th February 2003.

The Order was made on 6th November 2003, and comes into force on 1st January 2004.

R&O 124/2003

The purpose of these Bye-laws is to prescribe revised fees for applications for building work approval. The Bye-Laws were made on 6th November 2003, and come into force on 1st January 2004.
