THE STATES subsequently granted leave to the President of the Finance and Economics Committee to withdraw paragraph (b) of the principal proposition.

THE STATES adopted an amendment of Deputy Geoffrey Peter Southern of St. Helier that in paragraph (d), afte the words "Environment and Public Services Committee", there be inserted the words "and the Parishes"; after the words "environmental taxes" there be inserted the words "and other taxes,"; and, after paragraph (d)(ii), there be inserted the following new paragraph –

"(iii) a land value tax."

THE STATES, then resumed consideration of the proposition of the Finance and Economics Committee concerning a Fiscal Strategy as amended.
