REPORT

Due to the mortality suffered by the ormer population in 1999, the fishery was closed. The stock has now recovered sufficiently for the fishery to be reopened. This legislation repeals the regulation closing the fishery.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 2, 5, 8 and 22 of the Sea Fisheries (Jersey) Law 1994,^[1] having consulted with the Secretary of State and obtained the Secretary's concurrence, have made the following Regulations -

1. The Sea Fisheries (Ormers - Temporary Restrictions) (Jersey) Regulations 1999^[2] are repealed.
2. These Regulations may be cited as the Sea Fisheries (Ormers - Temporary Restrictions) (Repeal) (Jersey) Regulations 200 and shall come into force on promulgation.
