

Comprehensive Spending Review</b></p> <p>The Panel considered the areas it wished covered in the section of its draft report relating to the individual departments. It noted a large piece of work done by Deputy Vallois and thanked her for her considerable efforts in extracting information from the transcripts of the Public Hearings held with various Ministers. The Panel gave instruction on its requirements in the relevant section of the report. The question of how the savings had manifested into the Draft Annual Business Plan 2011 arose and examination of the figures led to confusion. It was noted that the presentation to States Members on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2010 had shown a 1% increase in Net Revenue Expenditure. These figures could not be found in the publication of the Draft Annual Business Plan 2011. Different figures raised numerous questions. An e-mail was to be sent to the Treasury Department for the figures to be explained. The problems with reconciling the figures were to be discussed in the CSR report.</p> <p>An early draft of the report would be available by 16<sup>th</sup> July 2010, although it was unlikely that the end of July deadline for the report would be achieved. It was noted that work would continue on the report until it was finalised and that could reasonably be expected by the 6<sup>th</sup> August 2010.</p>	MR / KB
