Draft Sea Fisheries (Minimum Size Limits) (Amendment No.6) (Jersey) Regulations 201- (P.93/2018) – comment. 350/99(2) 350/99(17)

A1. The Committee noted that the draft Sea Fisheries (Minimum Size Limits) (Amendment No.6) (Jersey) Regulations 201- (P.93/2018) and the draft Sea Fisheries (Les Ecréhous) (Jersey) Regulations 201- (P.94/2018), which had both been lodged *au Greffe* by the Minister for the Environment, made reference to the amendments being made '*following scientific evidence and discussions in the various Committees of the Granville Bay Agreement*'.

However, the Committee was of the view that neither Proposition contained the evidence to support this statement, or the information to enable States Members to make an informed decision. Accordingly, the Committee decided to present a comment on P.93/2018, which also referred to P.94/2018, to highlight this lacuna.

The Committee approved a draft comment and requested the Committee Clerk to arrange for the same to be presented to the States.
