Variety hasn't actually assisted families with respite but we have been very involved with projects at Oakwell ie., the extension to the building and the gardens. We have also provided many specialised pieces of equipment i.e, special beds, prams, trikes etc., not only to Oakwell but directly for the families. At a recent Christmas party that we organised we were approached by several families saying how desperate they were to get some respite and that whilst they were aware that the accommodation was available there were no funds for staffing.
