REPORT

To implement the scheme of The Law Society of Jersey Law 2005, it is necessary in the first instance to bring into force the provisions of the Law described in the Explanatory Note to this Act.

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from the Act.

Explanatory Note

The effect of this Order would be to bring into force on 1st January 2007 the provisions of The Law Society of Jersey Law 2005 other than those requiring practising advocates and solicitors of the Royal Court to be members of the Law Society of Jersey.

The provisions of Article 3 of the Law that do require practitioners to be members of the Society would then, in consequence of the making of the Act, come into force on 1st April 2007.
