## **DRAFT PUBLIC ELECTIONS (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200-**

### **REPORT**

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Article 7(1) of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002 requires the States to approve the form of the statement to be sent to every unit of dwelling accommodation to gather information of the names of persons entitled to have their names included on the electoral register for an electoral district.

All information is collected and used in compliance with the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 1987 for the purposes of the electoral register and jury service administration and all Parishes are registered with the Jersey Data Protection Registrar.

The Connétable of the Parish has to be satisfied that a person meets the criteria set out in Article 5(1) of the Law and is entitled on a particular day to have his/her name included on the electoral register. The information required is –

Full name of the person

Date of birth

Period of ordinary residence that is either –

A – ordinarily resident in the Island for a period of at least two years up to and including the day of application; or

B – ordinarily resident in the Island for a period of at least six months up to and including the day of application, as well as having been ordinarily resident in the Island at any time for an additional period of, or for additional periods that total, at least five years.

Signature confirming the above details and that the person is ordinarily resident at a particular address in the electoral district.

The statement also invites a person to give details of his/her occupation as this is used for the preparation of the jury service list in accordance with the Loi (1864) réglant la procédure criminelle. Provision of these details is not compulsory and, whether or not it is given, a person will be included on the electoral register if they satisfy the criteria set out in Article 5(1). If the occupation is given then a person's name may be omitted from the jury service list in accordance with the provisions of the 1864 Law.

There are no additional financial or manpower implications arising from the adoption of these draft Regulations by the States.

### **Explanatory Note**

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The object of these Regulations is amend the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002 to prescribe the form of annual statement to be sent out to households by Connétables when they gather the information to be included or updated in the electoral registers for their parishes.

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Articles 3, 7 and 72 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002,<sup>[1]</sup> have made the following Regulations –

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### **1 Regulation 3 amended**

For Regulation 3(1) of the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002<sup>[2]</sup> there shall be substituted the following paragraphs –

“(1) For the purposes of Article 3(a) of the Law,<sup>[3]</sup> the prescribed form of declaration is Form 1.

(1A) For the purposes of Article 7(1)(a) of the Law,<sup>[4]</sup> the prescribed form of statement is Form 1A.”.

### **2 Form 1A inserted**

In the Schedule to the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002<sup>[5]</sup> after Form 1 there shall be inserted Form 1A in the Schedule to these Regulations.

### **3 Citation and commencement**

These Regulations may be cited as the Public Elections (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on 6th April 2004.
