- (ii) those employees who were categorised as 'politically eligible' should be able to participate in political activities in accordance with the conditions set out in paragraphs 5.1 – 5.6 ("Proposed Standards of Conduct for Public Sector Employees engaging in Political Activities") of the said report;
 - (iii) those employees and office-holders who were categorised as 'politically ineligible' should be able to stand for election for the States in accordance with the conditions set out in the said paragraphs 5.6 – 5.10 and 6.1 – 6.3;
- (b) charged the Chief Minister, after consultation as necessary with the States Employment Board, to bring forward for approval the necessary legislation to give effect to the proposals.
