Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Law is to authorize the making and levying of rates in the parishes for the years 2004, 2005 and 2006.

This Draft Law has no implications for the financial or manpower resources of the States.

DRAFT PARISH RATE (JERSEY) LAW 200

A LAW to authorize the levy of rate in the parishes of the Island for 3 years.

Adopted by the States [date to be inserted]

Sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council [date to be inserted]

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

1 Parish rate authorized

A foncier rate and an occupier's rate are authorized to be made and levied in the parishes of the Island for the years 2004, 2005 and 2006, in accordance with the Parish Rate (Administration) (Jersey) Law 2003. ^[1]

2 Citation and commencement

- (1) This Law may be cited as the Parish Rate (Jersey) Law 200-.
- (2) It shall come into force on the seventh day following its registration.
