REPORT

Whilst wishing to acknowledge the Chief Minister's concerns in [P.59/2019 Amd.\(2\)](#) about the scale of the administrative burden that would be created by setting the reporting level at £1,000, in the interests of transparency, it is important that the reporting level is set below the threshold for financial directions.

I have therefore proposed a level of £20,000 because this will reduce the administrative burden whilst, importantly, also capturing those consulting contracts that have a value just below the threshold for financial directions.
