**Explanatory Note**

These Regulations increase the standard rate in respect of medical services provided by an approved medical practitioner from £10.00 to £10.50 with effect from 1st October 1999.

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**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Articles 18 and 46 of the Health Insurance (Jersey) Law 1967,<sup>1</sup> as amended,<sup>2</sup> have made the following Regulations -

1.-(1) In paragraph (1) of Regulation 2 of the Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) (Jersey) Regulations 1967,<sup>3</sup> as amended,<sup>1</sup> for the words "ten pounds" there shall be substituted the words "ten pounds fifty".

(2) The Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) (Amendment No. 46) (Jersey) Regulations 1996<sup>4</sup> are repealed.

(3) This Regulation shall apply in relation to medical services provided by an approved medical practitioner on or after the first day of October 1999.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Insurance (Medical Benefit) (Amendment No. 50) (Jersey) Regulations 1999.
