WRITTEN QUESTION TO THE MINISTER FOR TREASURY AND RESOURCES BY THE DEPUTY OF ST. MARY ANSWER TO BE TABLED ON TUESDAY 22nd JUNE 2010

Question

"Given that the Minister informed the Assembly that the Market Sub-Post Office turns over £1 million in a year, can the Minister tell members how many customers this represents?"

Answer

Unfortunately the Deputy is incorrect, on the 8th June, I informed the Assembly that the annual turnover of the <u>network</u> has reduced by £482k (8%) to £5.4m since 2008, and losses are forecast to increase by £412k to £1.2m over the same period.

I did not inform the assembly that the Central Market Sub post office turnover was £1m.
