3. Airport and Harbours

The Panel agreed the membership of the Airport and Harbours Sub-Panel as being Deputy M.R. Higgins, Deputy M. Tadier, Deputy T.A. Vallois and Deputy D.J. de Sousa. It was noted that in line with the Code of Practice for Scrutiny Panels and the Public Accounts Committee, as the only representative from the Deputy M.R. Higgins would be Chairman of the Sub-Panel as the only representative from the main Panel.

The Chairman confirmed that the Sub-Panel would undertake a Harbours focused Review before moving on to an Airport focused Review. The Harbours Review was scheduled to begin immediately and to be completed by the end of July 2010.

The Panel recalled its decision of 14th December 2009 that the Chairman would seek the advice of the Greffier of the States about a possible conflict of interest with the Airport, in view of his role in the organisation of the Jersey International Air Display. Based on his exchange with the Greffier, the Chairman advised that it was his decision to make as to whether he was conflicted in the matter. The Chairman understood this case to be a matter of perceived rather than actual conflict of interest, and had concluded that he was able to undertake the Review as he would do so in an open and evidence based manner.
