## **DRAFT CRIMINAL JUSTICE (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (JERSEY) LAW 201-**

### **European Convention on Human Rights**

## REPORT

---

1. This draft Law is concerned with –
  - (a) reforming the standard scale of fines;
  - (b) increasing the jurisdiction of the Magistrate’s Court to impose fines;
  - (c) widening the powers of the States to amend legislation with regard to (a) and (b) by Regulations.

*(a) Reforming the Standard Scale of Fines*

2. Since the current levels on the standard scale of fines came into effect on 2nd February 1994, the inflation calculator issued by the Statistics Unit shows that £50 at that time represents approximately £100 at today’s values.
3. The current standard scale is contained in the Schedule to the Criminal Justice (Standard Scale of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1993, and is as follows:

Level on the scale	Amount of fine
1	£50
2	£500
3	£2,000
4	£5,000

4. Whilst fines for some offences have been fixed at a given level on the standard scale for up to 20 years, fines for other offences have only been assigned a level in more recent years (*e.g.* under the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012, which came into force on 1st July 2013). The reform of the standard scale has not therefore been a simple matter of increasing the levels by the rate of inflation. Instead, a fresh approach has had to be taken to fixing such levels.
5. It is proposed – and more will be said about this presently – that the maximum jurisdiction of the Magistrate be increased to £10,000. From this starting point the standard scale will fix –
  - (a) the **level 1** fine at 2% of that jurisdiction (**£200**), and
  - (b) the **level 2** fine at 10% of that jurisdiction (**£1,000**), and
  - (c) the **level 3** fine at 100% of that jurisdiction (**£10,000**).
6. Beyond £10,000 will take fines into the jurisdiction of the Royal Court. The level of fines would then become unlimited. In other words, level 4 would cease to exist.
7. This is intended to work in the following way when deciding at what level the fine for a new offence should be fixed.
  - I The starting point will be to decide whether or not the offence could ever be serious enough to be dealt with by the Royal Court (*i.e.* whether it could ever merit a fine above £10,000).

- II If the offence could merit such a fine, it may be dealt with by the Royal Court, where it will fall to the Attorney General to move for sentence. There will be no need for a maximum level to be laid down by the States because the purpose of the Attorney General moving conclusions is to ensure consistency of sentencing practice in the Royal Court. The offence will therefore carry **an unlimited fine**.<sup>1</sup>
- III If the offence could never be serious enough to merit a fine of more than £10,000, it will need to be decided if the offence is potentially serious enough to merit a fine of more than £1,000.
- IV If it is serious enough to do so, the offence will carry **a level 3 fine** (£10,000) *i.e.* it will be in the discretion of the Magistrate to sentence as he or she sees fit to the limit of his/her jurisdiction.
- V If it is not serious enough to merit a fine of more than £1,000, it will need to be decided if the offence is still potentially serious enough to merit a fine of more than £200.
- VI If it is serious enough to do so, the offence will carry **a level 2 fine** (£1,000).
- VII If it is not serious enough to merit a fine of more than £200, the offence will carry the lowest fine, namely, **a level 1 fine** (£200).<sup>2</sup>
8. It is not possible in this Report to refer specifically to each fining provision contained in *Schedule 1* to the draft Law: the entire range of offences on the statute book is caught.
9. In some cases, the existing fine is still expressed in the relevant legislation in £ Sterling, and the conversion to the appropriate level on the standard scale – or to an unlimited fine – by this amending Law has been based on considerations such as the length of time the existing fine has remained the same, the perceived seriousness (or lack of seriousness) of the offence in present times and the need for deterrence, as well as comparing the penalty with those for similar offences in other jurisdictions.
10. In relation to the length of time an existing fine has remained the same, existing references to level 4 on the standard scale are replaced by either a reference to the new level 3 or to an unlimited fine. As a general rule –
- existing references to level 4 that were enacted before 27th October 2000<sup>3</sup> are replaced with references to an unlimited fine;
  - existing references to level 4 that were enacted after that date are replaced with a reference to the new level 3.<sup>4</sup>

11. *Schedule 2* to the draft Law relates to Orders in Council that provide for Acts of Parliament to have effect in Jersey and provides for references to existing levels on the standard scale to be construed as references to the appropriate new levels.<sup>5</sup>
12. It should be noted that the draft Law will not affect the current level of Centeniers' powers to levy a fine summarily. Although the amount in question – £200 – will remain the same, it will correspond to the new level 1, and will be expressed as such.

(b) *Increasing the jurisdiction of the Magistrate's Court to impose fines*

13. Article 3 of the [Magistrate's Court \(Miscellaneous Provisions\) \(Jersey\) Law 1949](#) ("the 1949 Law") provides that –
 

*“ . . . the maximum penalties which may be imposed by the Magistrate shall be a fine of £5,000 or imprisonment for a term of 12 months, or both such fine and such imprisonment, or such greater penalty as may be authorized by or by virtue of any Law or Order in Council to be imposed by the Magistrate's Court . . . Provided . . . that where a person is convicted of more than one offence, the aggregate of the fines imposed by the Magistrate in respect of those offences shall not exceed the maximum fine which the Magistrate is empowered by this paragraph to impose.”*
14. There is broad agreement that the maximum fining power of the Magistrate should be increased to £10,000. There is no intention to alter the maximum term of imprisonment that the Magistrate may impose.
15. The existing maximum level of fine came into effect in 2000,<sup>6</sup> almost 15 years ago, when it was increased from £2,000 to £5,000.
16. By way of historical background, before 1853, the Royal Court had jurisdiction to deal with all criminal matters serious or trivial. However, the *Loi (1853) établissant la Cour pour la répression des moindres délits* provided [in translation] that –
 

*“The Bailiff, the Lieutenant Bailiff, or the Petty Debts Court judge, shall sit . . . . in order to hear and to adjudicate upon ‘Causes de Police’ which may be heard and dealt with summarily, and for which the penalty does not exceed five pounds or eight days imprisonment. He shall hear the evidence in the more serious cases where the defendant has been arrested, in order to decide whether there are grounds to remand him in custody, or if he ought to be released, or if he should be admitted to bail; in this latter case, the Judge shall fix the amount of bail to be furnished.”*
17. This did not create ‘summary offences’ as such, but it did confer a discretion on the lower court to determine whether or not, on the facts, a penalty within its jurisdiction was merited. If the offence deserved a penalty within the jurisdiction of the Royal Court, the Police Court would remand the defendant up to the Royal Court for trial. The position remains unchanged to the present day in that Jersey law still does not classify criminal offences as being triable *only* by the Magistrate or *only* by the Royal Court. It remains in the discretion

of the Magistrate, on the facts before her, to decide whether she ought to deal with the offence or remand the case to the Royal Court.

18. What has changed, however, is the limit of the jurisdiction of the Magistrate's sentencing powers. Article 3 of the 1949 Law provided for a maximum fine of £50 or imprisonment not exceeding 3 months, or both. After that, the maximum fine was increased as follows –
- in 1960 to £100;
  - in 1970 to £200 (and the maximum imprisonment to 6 months);
  - in 1979 to £500;
  - in 1990 to £2,000;
  - in 2000 to £5,000 (and the maximum imprisonment increased to 12 months).

(c) *Widening the States' powers to amend legislation by Regulations*

19. The States are already empowered to amend amounts of fine that represent the different levels on the standard scale of fines.
20. This Law widens the powers of the States by enabling to be amended by Regulations –
- the maximum sentencing powers of the Magistrate;<sup>7</sup>
  - the amount or level of the fine in any enactment that may be imposed for an offence;
  - the fine that a Centenier may inflict and levy summarily where a person charged with an offence under an enactment accepts the decision of the Centenier;
  - Schedule 2 to this Law (which relates to penalties for offences under legislation extended by Order in Council).

### **Financial and manpower implications**

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from the adoption of this draft Law.

### **Human Rights**

No human rights notes are annexed because the Law Officers' Department has indicated that the draft Law does not give rise to any human rights issues.

## Explanatory Note

---

This Law makes miscellaneous amendments to enactments associated with the imposition of penalties for criminal offences.

*Article 1* amends the maximum penalty that may be imposed by the Magistrate for a criminal offence. Currently, the Magistrate may impose a monetary penalty of up to £5,000 and imprisonment for up to 12 months. This Law increases the monetary penalty that the Magistrate may impose to £10,000.

*Article 2* amends the standard scale of fines for a criminal offence. Currently the scale is as follows –

level 1	£50
level 2	£500
level 3	£2,000
level 4	£5,000 (equivalent to the Magistrate’s current maximum fining power).

The amendment revises and increases the scale as follows –

level 1	£200
level 2	£1,000
level 3	£10,000 (equivalent to the Magistrate’s proposed maximum fining power).

As a consequence of the proposed abolition of level 4 on the standard scale, existing references to that level are amended by *Schedule 1*, as described below.

*Article 3* gives effect to *Schedules 1 and 2* and empowers the States, by Regulations, to amend monetary penalties for offences and the maximum penalty that a centenier may levy for an offence. The effect of *Schedules 1 and 2* is described below.

*Article 4* repeals provisions of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956 that are made redundant by the changes to that Law that appear in *Schedule 1*.

*Article 5* provides for the citation and commencement of this Law.

*Schedule 1* amends penalties for offences. The amendments fall into 3 categories –

1. Existing references to level 4 on the standard scale are replaced by either a reference to level 3 on the standard scale (as amended) or to an unlimited fine. Existing references to level 4 that were enacted before 27th October 2000 are replaced with a reference to an unlimited fine. Existing references to level 4 that were enacted after that date are replaced with a reference to the proposed level 3 on the standard scale.

Note: by virtue of the Interpretation (Jersey) Law 1954, a reference simply to “a fine” is construed as a reference to an unlimited fine.

2. Penalties that are currently expressed in pounds sterling are converted to references to a level on the standard scale.



3. Existing limits on a centenier's power to impose a fine summarily, currently expressed as two-fifths of the current level 2 on the standard scale are converted to references to the proposed level 1 on the standard scale. The limit on a centenier's power therefore remains the same – £200.
4. The opportunity is taken to restate the amended penalties in a manner that is consistent with the house style used within the Law Draftsman's Office since 2003. In 2003, Article 13 of the Interpretation (Jersey) Law 1954 was amended with the effect that: (a) a reference to a penalty for an offence is read as meaning that the offence is punishable by a penalty not exceeding the penalty specified; and (b) where more than one penalty is specified for an offence, the penalties may be imposed alternatively or cumulatively. This makes it possible to express penalties more concisely. For example –

“liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 months or to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale, or to both such imprisonment and such fine”

becomes –

“liable to imprisonment for a term of 3 months and to a fine of level 2 on the standard scale”.

*Schedule 2* provides for the construction of Orders in Council that provide for Acts of Parliament to have effect in Jersey. Ultimately, these Orders in Council will be amended so as to replace references to level 4 on the Jersey standard scale. Until that happens, *Schedule 2* provides for such references to be construed as references to level 3 on the Jersey standard scale (as amended by this draft Law).

## **DRAFT CRIMINAL JUSTICE (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (JERSEY) LAW 201-**

**A LAW** to increase the standard scale of fines; to increase the sentencing powers of the Magistrate; to amend penalties for offences; to provide for the construction of fines in Orders in Council that have effect in Jersey; and for connected purposes

*Sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council* [date to be inserted]

**THE STATES**, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

### **1 Magistrate’s jurisdiction**

- (1) In Article 3(1) of the Magistrate’s Court (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Law 1949<sup>1</sup>, for the amount “£5,000” there shall be substituted the amount “£10,000”.
- (2) After Article 3(2) of the Magistrate’s Court (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Law 1949 there shall be added the following paragraph –  
“(3) The States may, by Regulations, amend in paragraph (1) the sentencing powers of the Magistrate.”.
- (3) In Article 1 of the Loi (1853) établissant la cour pour la répression des moindres délits<sup>2</sup>, the words “, et dont la punition n’excédera pas £5 d’amende ou 8 jours d’emprisonnement” shall be deleted.

### **2 Standard scale of fines**

For the standard scale set out in the Schedule to the Criminal Justice (Standard Scale of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1993<sup>3</sup> there shall be substituted the following standard scale –

**“THE STANDARD SCALE**

<b>First column</b>	<b>Second column</b>
<b>Level on the scale</b>	<b>Amount of fine</b>
1	£200
2	£1,000
3	£10,000”.

**3 Amendment of enactments and construction of Orders in Council**

- (1) In an enactment described in the first column of Schedule 1, for the words in the second column opposite it, there shall be substituted the words in the third column.
- (2) The States may, by Regulations, amend in any enactment the amount or level of the fine that may be imposed for an offence.
- (3) The States may, by Regulations, amend in any enactment the fine that a centenier may inflict and levy summarily where a person charged with an offence under an enactment accepts the decision of the centenier.
- (4) The amendment of a subordinate enactment by or under this Law does not prevent or limit the further amendment of the enactment, in exercise of the power under which it is made.
- (5) In an Order in Council described in the first column of Schedule 2, the words in the second column opposite it shall be construed as if they were the words in column 3.
- (6) The States may, by Regulations, amend Schedule 2.

**4 Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956 amended**

The following provisions of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956<sup>4</sup> are repealed –

- (a) Article 25(3);
- (b) Article 27(3);
- (c) Article 88.

**5 Citation and commencement**

This Law may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Law 201- and shall come into force on such day or days as the States by Act appoint.
