## **Explanatory Note**

These Regulations specify the rates and amounts for the purposes of calculating the annual rate of family allowance during the family allowance year beginning on Tuesday, 5th January 1999.

## Family Allowances (Jersey) Law 1972

**THE STATES,** in pursuance of Article 7 of the Family Allowances (Jersey) Law 1972, as amended, have made the following Regulations -

- 1. For the purposes of paragraph (1) of Article 7 of the Family Allowances (Jersey) Law 1972, as amended, the following amounts are specified in respect of the family allowance year beginning on Tuesday, the fifth day of January 1999 -
  - (a) £2,397 shall be the maximum annual rate of the allowance in respect of the first child of a family;
  - (b) £2,047 shall be the maximum annual rate of the allowance in respect of the second child of a family;
  - (c) £1,839 shall be the maximum annual rate of the allowance in respect of each of the children of a family born after the first two children;
  - (d) £6,600 shall be the decline point;

- (e) the amount found by adding to £11,320 the sum of £2,200 in respect of each child of the family shall be the maximum level of family income; and
- (f) £52 shall be the minimum annual rate of the allowance in respect of each child of a family.
- 2. The Family Allowances (Jersey) Regulations 1997<sup>3</sup> are repealed.
- **3.** These Regulations may be cited as the Family Allowances (Jersey) Regulations 1998 and shall come into force on the fifth day of January 1999.
