Explanatory Note

These Regulations increase the maximum fines which may be imposed for each level of the standard scale of fines set out in the Criminal Justice (Standard Scale of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1993 as follows:

<i>level on the scale</i>	<i>old maximum fine</i>	<i>new maximum fine</i>
1	£50	£60
2	£500	£600
3	£2,000	£2,500
4	£5,000	£6,000

There has been a 23.8 per cent increase in the cost of living between the time when the Law came into force (February 1994) and June 1998.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 1 of the Criminal Justice (Standard Scale of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1993,¹ as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Law”), have made the following Regulations -

1. For the amounts specified in the second column of the standard scale of fines set out in the Schedule to the Law,² there shall be substituted the following amounts -

- (a) for the amount of £50 in respect of level 1 on the scale there shall be substituted “£60”;
- (b) for the amount of £500 in respect of level 2 on the scale there shall be substituted “£600”;
- (c) for the amount of £2,000 in respect of level 3 on the scale there shall be substituted “£2,500”; and
- (d) for the amount of £5,000 in respect of level 4 on the scale there shall be substituted “£6,000”.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Standard Scale of Fines) (Jersey) Regulations 199 and shall come into force on the first day of January 2000.
