I am writing to you with regards to the possibility of the states providing 20hrs paid nursery care for 3 to 4 year olds.

My daughter has just turned three and is at a fee paying preschool as I have to go to work - she has attended since the age of 8 months old. The school I am sending her to has not got a preschool attached to it, therefore I would have to move her to a states preschool in order for me not to have to pay fees for a year.
