DRAFT POSTAL SERVICES (TRANSFER) (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 201-

REPORT

These Regulations amend the Postal Services (Transfer) (Jersey) Regulations 2006 in relation to a condition set out in the Schedule concerning the premises used for postal headquarters in Rue des Prés Trading Estate. This condition currently requires the consent of the Minister for the Environment to change the use to which the premises are put or to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of the premises. Under *Regulation 1*, the consent of the Minister for Infrastructure is required instead of the Minister for the Environment.

Regulation 2 sets out the title of these Regulations and provides that they will come into force on the day after they are made.

The Minister for the Environment and the Minister for Infrastructure agree that the 'consent' role sits better under the responsibilities of the Minister for Infrastructure.

Collective responsibility under Standing Order 21(3A)

The Council of Ministers has a single policy position on this proposition, and as such, all Ministers, and the Assistant Minister for the Environment, are bound by the principle of collective responsibility to support the proposition, as outlined in the Code of Conduct and Practice for Ministers and Assistant Ministers ([R.11/2015](#) refers).

Financial and manpower implications

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from the adoption of these draft Regulations.

Explanatory Note

These Regulations amend the Postal Services (Transfer) (Jersey) Regulations 2006 in relation to a condition set out in the Schedule concerning the premises used for postal headquarters in Rue des Prés Trading Estate. THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 35(2) of the Postal Services (Jersey) Law 2004,¹ have made the following Regulations –

1 Postal Services (Transfer) (Jersey) Regulations 2006 amended

In paragraph 9 of Schedule 1 to the Postal Services (Transfer) (Jersey) Regulations 2006², for the words “Minister for the Environment” in each place they appear there shall be substituted the words “Minister for Infrastructure”.

2 Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Postal Services (Transfer) (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 201- and shall come into force on the day after the day they are made.
