Dear Sirs,

I am writing with reference to the Review of Speed Limit Policy.

We live in a green lane with 15.m.p.h. painted on the tarmac, which by most motorists is totally ignored, we have a lot of walkers and horses etc who use this lane and the speed of some motorists using this lane have no regard for the people on foot etc.,

I would like to suggest as follows:

1. Police presence i.e states or parish on small motorbikes who can move around parish lanes at various times, between 8.15am – 9am and 2.30pm-approx 3.30pm especially for the school run.
2. Fines on the spot i.e. one pound per mile over speed limit.
3. 20m.p.h speed limit maximum.
4. Larger warning signs on poles NOT smiley faces.

Something needs to be done to make these lanes safer.
