

**WRITTEN QUESTION TO THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES
BY DEPUTY M.R. LE HEGARAT OF ST. HELIER
ANSWER TO BE TABLED ON TUESDAY 20th NOVEMBER 2018**

Question

Will the Minister advise –

- (a) how many staff are allocated to Children's Health;
- (b) how many of those staff are working in Mental Health;
- (c) what the budget for Children's Health is; and
- (d) what vacancies, if any, there are in Children's Health?

Answer

- (a) there are 183.73 WTE posts allocated to Children's Health*
- (b) there are 19.1 WTE posts within CAMHS
- (c) the budget for Children's Health is £22,342,273
- (d) there are a total of 8.34 vacancies in Children's Health**

* Children's Health includes the following:

- Assisted Reproduction
- Maternity
- Paediatrics
- SCBU (Special Care Baby Unit)
- Obs & Gynae
- CAMHS (Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services)

** There are 3 WTE vacancies in CAMHS, 3 WTE vacancies on Robin Ward and 2.34 vacancies in Maternity
