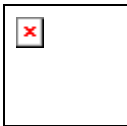

## **Report**

As drafted, Article 30(3) of the draft Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 200- would oblige the Board of Arbitrators to accept the judgement of the Industries Committee in respect of any enhancement to the value of land occasioned by the expenditure of public money.

It must be wrong to put the Board under a duty to follow an opinion other than its own, and especially the opinion of one of the parties to the situation in which the Board has been called upon to arbitrate.

My amendment obliges the Board of Arbitrators to *consider* the question of enhanced land value arising from the expenditure of public money, and to come to its own conclusion.

The amendment has no financial or manpower implications.
