This recommendation is now no longer relevant, as the review was on the 'Our Hospital Project', which has been replaced by the 'New Healthcare Facilities Programme' (NHF). The NHF Programme team are updating the project risk register as part of the ongoing management of the overall programme and a separate project risk register is being maintained for the Overdale Acute Project (which in itself consists of a number of projects).
