WRITTEN QUESTION TO THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES BY DEPUTY S.S.P.A. POWER OF ST. BRELADE ANSWER TO BE TABLED ON MONDAY 22nd SEPTEMBER 2014

Question

Can the Minister inform members whether charges for the disposal of clinical waste, green waste and other waste disposal charges are applied evenly to all third sector charities and can be provide details of any charities that have exemptions for any or all of these charges?

Answer

There is no blanket exemption for disposal charges to charities. Some charges have been waived for charities and this has happened on a case by case basis following a request from the charity to the Minister for Transport and Technical Services.

The charges waived are:-

Jersey Battle of Flowers Green waste disposal following the Battle of Flowers.

Les Amis Green waste disposal for waste generated from domestic work on own

houses.

Jersey Hospice Care Green waste disposal for Christmas tree initiative and inert waste

disposal for crockery.
