	9. Conflicts of Interest	
	Consideration was given to the importance of Panel Members recognising when there may be a Member with a conflict of interest in a review topic. It was agreed that it was very important to declare these and to stand down from all reviews where there were such conflicts.	
	The Committee agreed that: a) all consideration and/or declarations of conflicts of interest must be included on the Panel template of information for the Chairmen's Committee; b) the Code of Practice 4.23 to 4.25 must be followed and any doubts about this matter raised at the Chairmen's Committee meetings; c) the promotion of personal agendas through the scrutiny function must also be avoided.
