“Would the Minister advise whether there is or will be a new senior post for Human Resources (HR) at Health and Social Services, and, if so, will he explain how the current policy providing a centralised HR function is affected by having departmental HR capacity as well?”

5. Senator A. Breckon will ask the following question of the Minister for Treasury and Resources –

“Can the Minister advise the Assembly when he will provide the report as he was requested to do during the Housing Development Fund debate (P.61/2010) on 6th July 2010?”

## **Explanatory Note regarding subordinate legislation tabled at this meeting.**

### **R&O.29/2011.**

This Order gives effect in Jersey to Council Regulation (EU) No. 101/2011 of 4 February 2011 concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Tunisia.

The Order was made on 11th March 2011 and came into force on 12th March 2011.

### **R&O.30/2011.**

This Order gives effect in Jersey to Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 233/2011 of 10 March 2011 implementing Article 16(2) of Regulation (EU) No. 204/2011 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya. The Council Implementing Regulation adds to the list of persons and entities listed in Regulation (EU) 204/2011 against whom restrictions are imposed, in view of the situation in Libya.

The Order was made on 11th March 2011 and came into force on 12th March 2011.
