Article 35	<p>To issue a safe manning document that may exempt a ship or description of ship from a requirement of the U.K. Training and Certification Regulations or the U.K. Manning Regulations as applied in Jersey.</p> <p>The Officer shall only do so in accordance with existing policy guidance published with the endorsement of the Minister or where he/she is satisfied that there are equivalent arrangements in place appropriate to the ship type and area of operations.</p>	<p>Group Director – Economy</p> <p>Registrar of Shipping/ Harbour Master</p> <p>Assistant Registrar of Shipping (on behalf of Registrar)</p> <p>Chief Marine Surveyor</p>
