Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Act is to make Monday, 28th December 1998 a public holiday instead of Saturday, 26th December 1998.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Law 1951, as amended,¹ have made the following Act -

1. For the year nineteen hundred and ninety-eight the Schedule to the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Act 1952² shall have effect as if for the item "The twenty-sixth day of December, if a week day" there were substituted "The twenty-eighth day of December".

2. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays and Bank Holidays (Jersey) Act 1998.
