Report

On 16th October 2002, the Gambling Control Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under Regulation 6 (15) and (16) of the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows -

“A1. The Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, decided, with immediate effect, to delegate to the Executive Director and the Lottery Controller its functions under Regulation 6 (15) and (16) of the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended, as follows -

Legislation: Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended, Regulation 6

Delegate: (a) the Executive Director
(b) the Lottery Controller

Functions delegated: (a) in accordance with paragraph (15), to approve the appointment of an officer where a body corporate is the holder of a licence.

(b) in accordance with paragraph (16), to approve any change to the lay-out of the premises to which a current amusement premises licence, track licence or betting office licence (other than a credit betting office licence) relates, which affects the means of access thereto.

The Greffier of the States was requested to make the necessary arrangements for this Act to be presented to the States as a Rapport et Correspondance at the earliest opportunity.”.
