"offices" there should be substituted the word "office"; the words "Connétable and" should be deleted; for the words "one Deputy from each of the nine electoral constituencies", there should be substituted the words, "the role of the Connétables as Voting Members"; and for the word "nine" there should be substituted the word "twelve".
