 - (i) to introduce a 9-month CHWL permission that did not lead to permanent residential status;
 - (ii) to introduce a 4-year CHWL permission that did not lead to permanent residential status;
 - (iii) to introduce a 10-year CHWL permission that might lead to permanent residential status;
 - (iv) to introduce a long-term CHWL permission that provided permanent residential status;
 - (v) to require the applicant for a new permit to make a declaration of any unspent criminal convictions; and
 - (vi) to introduce enhanced identity requirements for all CHWL cards issued to new residents.
