Question

“Will the Minister state the amount of Government expenditure across the following areas of education for each year between 2018 and 2022 –

- (a) primary schools;
- (b) secondary schools; and
- (c) university and tertiary education?”

Answer

- (a) The amount of Government expenditure on primary schools between 2018 and 2022:
