This Act would appoint 1st March 2000 as the day on which the Arbitration (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 1999 would come into force.

The Law was considered and adopted by the States on 7th July 1999 (P.78 of 1999). It received the Royal Sanction on 12th October 1999, and was registered in the Royal Court on 5th November 1999. Its purpose is to remove discriminatory provisions in the Arbitration (Jersey) Law 1998, between domestic and foreign arbitration agreements. These contravene European Union requirements.

It is proposed to bring the Law into force simultaneously with the Arbitration (Jersey) Law 1998 itself, on 1st March 2000. A separate Appointed Day Act has accordingly been lodged in respect of the principal Law, for consideration at the same time as the present Act.

Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Act is to appoint 1st March 2000 as the day for the commencement of the Arbitration (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 1999, which was adopted by the States on 7th July 1999 (P.78 of 1999).

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Arbitration (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 1999,^[1] have made the following Act -

1. The Arbitration (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 1999 shall come into force on the first day of March 2000.
2. This Act may be cited as the Arbitration (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 1999 (Appointed Day) Act 2000.
