Code of Practice for Scrutiny Panels and the Public Accounts Committee: amendments P.49/2011

- (b) in paragraph 4.25, after the words “Rapporteurs will progress their investigations on their own initiative and direction” there should be inserted the words –

“through fact-finding visits, calls for public submissions but not hearings”.

 - (vii) to review the voting system by which appointments were made when more than 2 candidates were contesting a position;
- (b) to request the Privileges and Procedures Committee to report back to the States with recommendations following the conclusion of its review of the matters listed in paragraph (a).
