**Explanatory Note regarding subordinate legislation

R & O 9423

This Order provides for the closing of public roads and places to enable the holding of the Jersey Battle of Flowers, that is -

- the Grand Town Parade on Tuesday 10th August 1999;
- the Battle of Flowers proper on Thursday 12th August 1999; and
- the Moonlight Parade on Friday 13th August 1999.

The Order also sets out certain conditions relating to these closures.

The Order was made on 19th July 1999.

R & O 9424

The purpose of this Order is to make it an offence for a person to consume alcohol in a parking place when it is available for use as such. In addition a car park official is given power to require a person in a parking place whom he reasonably believes is not parking or collecting a motor vehicle to leave that parking place.

By amendments to the First and Fourth Schedules, the new Waterfront Car Park, in those spaces available for use by the public, in St. Helier is made a public parking place with a maximum stay of 4 hours and a parking fee, by Paycard, of 35p per hour.

The Order was made on 19th July 1999 and comes into force on 2nd August 1999.
