	5. Traffic and transport	
514/1(25)	Following discussion of traffic congestion and associated issues with the Minister for Transport and Technical Services at the quarterly public hearing on 11th November 2013, members considered whether this would be an appropriate subject for review. It appeared	

that the department was unwilling or unable to consider radical alternatives to bring about reduced congestion and improve traffic flow, and the Panel believed that progress with the new bus service and the Sustainable Transport Policy was potentially being hampered as a result. Members noted that this was likely to be a	
topic of considerable public interest and were in favour of carrying out a review in 2014. The Scrutiny Officer was asked to discuss the possibilities with department officers and report back to the Panel.	МО
